### Irvine-based LCS Constructors completes ExxonMobil facility

The 10,000-square-foot space includes a lab to test petroleum products before they are distributed.

Constructors recently completed work on ExxonMobil's new 10,000-square-foot quality-assurance laboratory at the company's refinery complex in Torrance.

LCS Constructors, Inc.

LCS, which was selected

for the project in 2008, began excavation and site development in April of last year.

The firm worked with architects at TomkoWoll to design and develop the single-story facility, which includes a lab to test the refinery's petroleum products before they are distributed.

Additionally, the plant incorporates energy-efficient lighting, electrical and mechanical design elements.

The facility is among more than 3,000 laboratories and technology plants across the nation that LCS has completed since its inception in 1980.

Current work includes renovations at Irvine-based Plus Diagnostics' new 27,000-square-foot complex, which is slated for completion in the third quarter, and a laboratory design project for Chevron Phillips/Worley Parsons' new 9,000-square-foot facility expansion in Saudi Arabia. This development is expected to be finished in the fourth quarter.

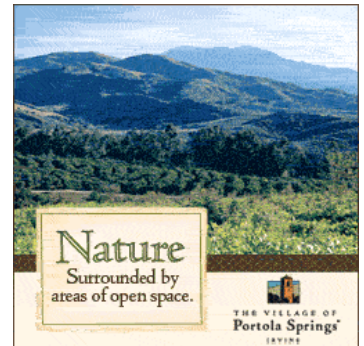
